AMNESTY



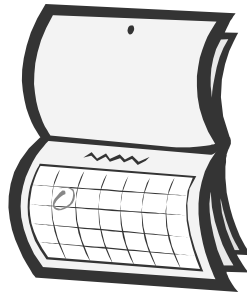
