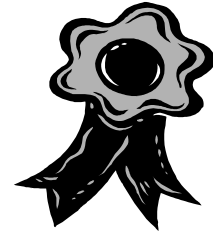
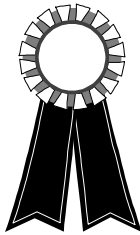

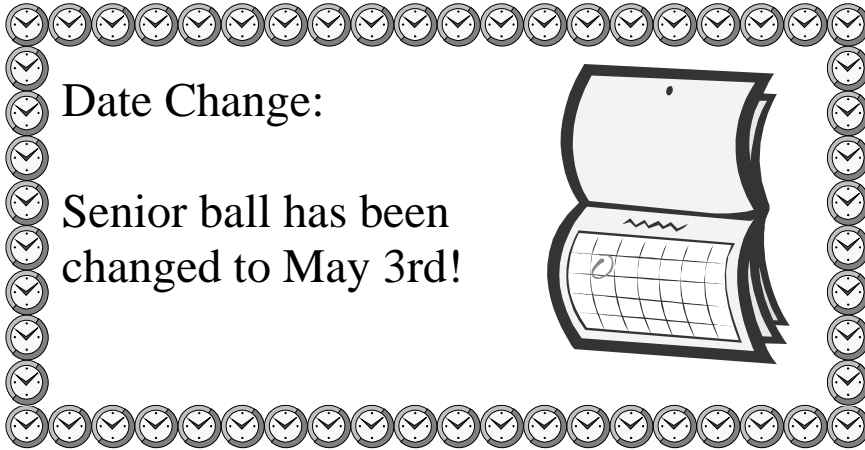
Honor s Nigh t

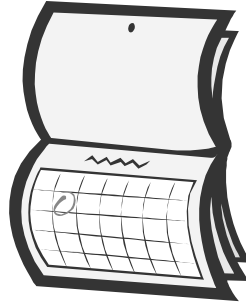

Financial Aid

CBA Financial Aid

The CBA Financial Aid applications will be mailed to all families who received aid for the 2001-02 school year. Please call the Finance Office if you DO NOT receive an application by March 1, 2002. Also, next year's budget has an increase in the allotment of CBA Financial Aid. CBA aid is based upon many variables, including income, liquid assets, and number of children attending parochial schools or children in college. We strongly urge families to apply if you feel you may qualify and you must apply to receive aid. Please call the Finance Office for an application. The deadline for completed applications for aid is March 31, 2002. There is a \$16 processing fee.

TAP

The Diocese of Syracuse also grants aid to families for a Catholic education (referred to as TAP). According to Sister Patricia Gibson, from the diocesan office... "The Tuition Assistance Program endeavors to help those who are in the lowest economic bracket and those in a middle economic bracket but who have several children. In spite of rising tuition rates, those in higher income brackets not only do not qualify but, should also not apply."

Also, please note that there are two changes this year for TAP: the due date for application is April 1, 2002, and the fee to be paid by the family has increased to \$10.
